On June 4, community is invited to join the effort to help youth find success by attending a Garden Fair to benefit Living Independently with Knowledge (LINK), the **organization's street outreach** service for youth in Rochester. The fourth annual Garden Fair, located at the Olmsted County History Center, will include vendors offering garden art, flower and vegetable plants and various products for experienced or amateur gardeners. Information seminars including *Beyond Green: Vibrant Landscapes* and *Living through Permaculture* presented by Bruce Blair, owner/designer of Homestead Gardens, will introduce new gardening techniques. 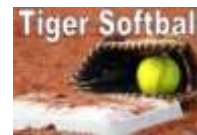
FAITH ON THE GO
