WORSHIP SPACE AS PRAY GROUND

Adults know well that worship is a place to pray, praise, and hear **God's Word. At Our Saviors we** want that for our children as well. - Blankets
- Having the Bible story table and figures available for young children to play

As you travel this summer, keep your eyes open for what other churches are doing. Parents be sure to use and encourage your children to use whatever toys and resources you want. Make suggestions about what works, **what doesn't, and ideas of other things you'd like.**
