

How's That Work Again? - Confirmation

For decades. Pastor Fred and I had walked through Confirmation Classes with young people – teaching them, helping them grow, building relationships – only for them to get confirmed and then disappear from the life of the congregation. Confirmation Sunday had become Graduation Sunday, because the students had reached the end of their "church school." So in 2017, we shifted up our faithformation model. Since then, we have intentionally worked to separate Confirmation (when our young people have been publicly affirmed in the promises that God made to them in baptism) from graduation ("to receive a degree or diploma on completing a course of study"). To facilitate this, we did away with separate Confirmation Classes, focusing instead on offering new methods of faith-formation.

However, these new methods were not connecting with our youth and families like we had hoped they would. So in April, we began experimenting with a new type of Confirmation Class: we would meet once a month on a Sunday evening; we would share a meal, then learn; it would be for youth grades 6-12; and at least one parent or caring adult would be there for each youth.

All along, when they are in 9th grade, kids have been affirmed in the promises of baptism – this will not change; but notice that these classes are open to kids *beyond* their 9th grade year. This is because Confirmation is not graduation. It is there for our youth and their parents to grow in faith and life, and build relationships with God, each other, and the pastors.

If you'd like to help out with this, or if you'd like to join in the fun in some way, please talk to me! I'd love for more of our adults to help pass on the faith!
