Business Admin Teams (Tim Valen)

- Audit date on January 14.
- Review of year, as submitted by Jon Christenson for the annual meeting: There were some challenges this year that we had to address.

We reviewed our insurance coverage as there was a substantial increase in property coverage. It ended up being from all the claims from the storms down south and everyone was affected, not just Our Saviors. We also discovered there was a gap in our workman's comp coverage and worked with our agent to quickly resolve the issue.

We also had some building issues that had to be addressed. A leaking roof and some HVAC issues.

We reviewed our reserve funds and were able to use some of them to get the roof repaired.

The good news is our CDs are performing as expected.

And we were still able to stay under budget for the year.

I would like to thank our Treasurer Emily Block and our Financial Secretary Tim Hornseth for all their hard work and dedication this year.

And thanks to the committee members for the past year.

With Pastor Nikki taking a new call, many of us might have been wondering what that means for the future of the Shared Ministry between Good Shepherd and Our Savior's.

The good news is that our Shared Ministry will continue for the immediate future! The Joint Ministry Team (made up of members from both congregations), Councils, Key Volunteers, Committees, Staff, and Pastors are fully committed to continuing this partnership through the established relationships created through Pastor Nikki's ministry with us. We have at least one joint worship service, monthly joint youth group activities, and the joint Summer Youth Mission Trip to look forward to!

That said, our Shared Ministry is heading into a new phase. We will not be seeking to fill Pastor Nikki's position at this time. The Joint Ministry Team and our respective councils will be engaged in active discernment about the future of this partnership and any future staffing that it may necessitate. In the coming months, the Team is looking to involve the members of the congregations in conversation about priorities and possibilities for the future.
