Shared Ministry Team (Katie Zahasky)

Most recent meeting- 12/3/24 Meeting

<u>Pastor Nikki</u> - updates about how the shared ministry (time management, opportunities/challenges)-She is leaving OSLC, having accepted a call at Lands Lutheran in Zumbrota. Her last service to preach was 12/8/24 at GSC and 12/22/24 at OSLC.

The youth went on a service trip and the two groups did things well together.

Upcoming Nashville trip involves mainly just getting there with most of the other work being taken care of. Two vans are rented from Kuehn. Colin and Carl-Eric are going but more female chaperones are needed. Colin is currently in charge of the trip, \$400/child and no food costs. Pastor Carl-Eric is going to make sure this year's youth event goes off.

Pastor Carl Eric - has been in communication with Pastor Ben about where we go from here.

<u>Pastor Ben</u> - Lay Ministry is just beginning at GSC, shared family ministry events going well, joint worship has gone well. What can we do apart from a shared staff person or what other options are available.

- Discuss survey feedback from our congregations over 3/4th are in favor of continuing, over 3/4th had positive experiences, some outliers wanted to merge the two churches, other outliers were resistant because of fear of losing congregational identity.
- Year-end reflections on other 2024 SM activities (national youth gathering, Fair, Trade, joint worship services, podcasts, intergenerational projects, family game nights, etc.)

Plans for 2025-2026

- Plan- create a statement for the desire of continuing the collaboration to go to both congregations before the annual meetings. Reminding them the focus of the collaborative was initially for Lay Ministry and Youth Ministry including seeking volunteers for the committee to discern opportunities for new directions
- Updates on Tanzania trip OSLC has a ministry partnership with the palliative care program at lambi Lutheran Hospital in Tanzania. In the beginning stages of planning another trip, for 2025 at the earliest, but more likely for 2026.

 - Broad overview of property needs:
 - Worse parts of parking lot ~ \$20,000-30,000 (total parking lot repair/replace~ \$156,000)
 - More roof repairs ~ \$40,000
 - $\circ~$ A/C (condenser units) -one is not working, both bought at the same time, replacement x 2 $\,\sim\,$ \$68,000
